Anser Charter School	The Anser Charter School Bicycle Project	This mobile classroom will open up opportunities for our students at Anser to get outside the four walls and to learn more about themselves through the lens of the outdoors.
Butte County Soil and Water Conservation District	Natural Resources Tour & Stewardship Week	Natural resources educational outreach project will engage youth of all ages in learning about pollinators of all types and encourage youth to be actively involved in pollinator conservation.
Canyon County Parks	Canoe Science Camps at Lake Lowell	Paid college interns are lead canoe guides and field instructors for these week-long outdoor education programs. They guide our youth participants through an immersive experience of science, community and place at Lake Lowell: canoeing, swimming, hiking, playing, learning and serving. Interns teach participants how to paddle a canoe, how to investigate water quality using scientific equipment, and how to identify and respect local wildlife.

Offering 80+ birding field trips that are free and open to the public, including monthly beginner and family-friendly guided bird walks in local parks; 2. Providing binoculars to local classrooms, scouting groups, and other organizations through our binocular-loan program; and 3. increasing K-12 classroom and in-the-field environmental education for 400+ people in our community and providing in-depth offerings for refugee and immigrant youth through our New Roots Program.
