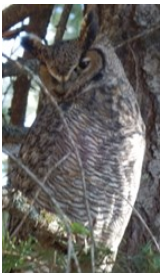
3. Mule deer can run 45 mph. They can cover 50 yards in 2.3 seconds.

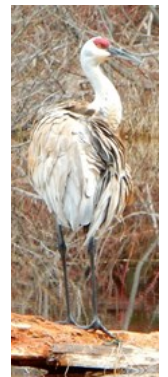
6. A river otter can hold its breath under water for 8 minutes.
