The Mission of the Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation is to improve the quality of life in Idaho through outdoor recreation and resource stewardship.

Outline of duties for a volunteer interpretive internship working at Lucky Peak State Park in Boise May through August 2019:

Provide general assistance with administration of the Experience/Education program through conducting research, helping to coordinate supplies needed for park educational programs, assisting with the creation of educational materials and printing of manuals, and assisting with and participating in interpretive training. Lead interpretive programs in Boise area state parks including Eagle Island State Park and Lucky Peak State Park. Minimum of ten hours per week.

Examples of specific duties include:

- Attend Interpretive Training June 11-13, 2019 at Harriman State Park. Lodging and food provided.
- Lead interpretive programs in Lucky Peak State Park.
- Assist with special events.
- General assistance with administration of Experience/Education program.
- Lead Junior Ranger programs.
