


Farragut STATE PARK

- Motorized vehicles are allowed only on designated roads, which are those shown on this map and not closed by gate or signage.
- Motorized vehicles within park boundaries must have a park permit and be street legal, licensed, and insured.
- Horse, llama, or any stock animal use is restricted to the park areas North of Highway 54.




TRAIL TIPS:

Farragut has an extensive and diverse trail system. Detailed trail maps are recommended and available for purchase at the Park Visitor Center.


Locust Grove Group Camp



Thimbleberry Group Camp




Buttonhook Group Camps
