

Lakeview Cabins at Ponderosa State Park

Ponderosa State Park has five cabins nestled along the shore of Payette Lake. These cabins are fully equipped with all the comforts of home. Step inside to an equipped kitchen with full size stove, refrigerator, microwave and dishwasher. Also included in the kitchen; cookware, bake ware, dinnerware, utensils, glasses, cutlery, coffee maker, and toaster. Three cabins have a separate bedroom with queen bed, double hide-a-bed in the living room, and two (2) twin mattresses in the loft; a pass-thru style bathroom with bath tub/shower and toilet behind one door and a double vanity across the way. The Moose cabin has a separate bedroom with queen bed, single hide-a-bed in the living room, and two (2) twin mattresses in the loft; a pass-thru style bathroom with roll in style shower, toilet and a single vanity across the way. The Elk cabin has a separate bedroom with queen bed, a double hide-a-bed in living room, a queen bed and double hide-a-bed in the loft, and a traditional bathroom. Kitchen, bedroom and bathroom linens are provided. Step outside to a covered deck with awesome views of Payette Lake, gorgeous sunsets and easy access to one of the largest sand beaches on the lake.

The cabins can be reserved year round and reservations are accepted up to nine (9) months in advance, but no less than two (2) days prior to your arrival date. Availability can be viewed on line at www.parksandrecreation.idaho.gov ; to make a reservation please call 1-888-922-6743.

Fees accommodate only one (1) Motor Vehicle Entrance Fee, all others must pay upon arrival at the park. All vehicles have to park in the designated parking area nearby. Towed items must park in upper parking area.

Additional camping equipment or awnings will not be permitted at the cabins.

Pets are not allowed at the cabins.

Check in after 3:00 pm on your arrival date; check out by 12:00 pm on your departure date.

Descriptions:

Bear- Sleeps 6, Located near the Visitor Center; has open view of the lawn area and views of the lake.

Wolf- Sleeps 6, Situated on a small bluff with an open view of the lake.

Fox- Sleeps 6, Sits on a bluff adjacent to the Wolf cabin with an open view of the lake.

Moose- Sleeps 5, ADA accessible; situated on a bluff with views of the lake.

Elk- Sleeps 8, Nestled in the trees with views of the lake.
