Groups must abide by IDPR Rules and Regulations. Each group must assign a group representative to sign the user agreement form and inform all group members of the following specific park rules.

Facility Rules

- Maximum capacity of each facility shall not be exceeded.
- Check-in is 3:00 pm and check-out is noon.
- Camping is prohibited in Harriman State Park and pets are not allowed in rental facilities.
- Renters of the Dormitory **ARE REQUIRED** to clean facilities (dormitory and cookhouse) upon departure.

Parking

- During snow-free months, parking for Yurt users is provided at the Yurt site. All other overnight guests may park at the dormitory. Vehicles are not permitted beyond that point.
- During winter months, parking is provided ¼ mile from the Yurts and 1 mile from the remaining rentals. All supplies must be packed by ski or snowshoe. Snowmobiles are not allowed in the park.

Fees

- Overnight guests must pay the Nordic Grooming Fee if applicable. Sales tax will be collected on the sale of all goods and services.
- Cancellations made 21 days or more prior to your arrival date will result in a \$50 Cancellation fee.
- Cancellation less than 21 days prior to your arrival date, the first nights fee is forfeited.
- A \$150 cleaning deposit is required for the dormitory (2) weeks prior to arrival. A \$50 fee may be assessed to alter a confirmed reservation.

I have read and understand the policies for using Harriman State Park overnight facilities and agree to take responsibility for the conduct of my group and agree to compensate the Department of Parks and Recreation for any damage, beyond normal wear and tear, incurred to park facilities by those of my group. I agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Department for facility use. The Park Manager shall have the authority to deny a reservation to any group, whose behavior has violated Department of Parks and Recreation rules and regulations.
