CABIN RENTAL RULES

- ⇒ All renters must comply with all park rules and regulations as required by all park visitors.
- ⇒ There is a \$4.00/night Day Use Entrance Fee for each vehicle in all day use areas and campgrounds. The MVEF is not required while parked in the driveway at the rental cottage.
- ⇒ Check-in time 3 p.m. or later. Check-out time 12 noon or earlier.
- ⇒ RV's, tent trailers, tents are not permitted at the cottages. Please use one of the campgrounds.
- ⇒ Renters may use the public boat moorage available in the park or if renting the Lakeview cottage, renter may use the shared Lakeview cottage dock.
- ⇒ Pets are allowed in the Rocky Point and Lakeview Cottages. Pets may not be left unattended.
- ⇒ Cleaning supplies are provided and renters are responsible for daily cleaning of cottage. Cottage renters are responsible for daily cleaning of the cabin during their stay.
- ⇒ Park quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- ⇒ No smoking in any park facilities.
- ⇒ Renters must use designated parking areas established for the cottage.
- ⇒ **CANCELLATION POLICY:** Cancellations made 21 days or more prior to your arrival date will result in a \$50.00 cancellation fee. If calling less than 21 days prior to your arrival date, the first nights fee is forfeited.

Check In

To facilitate late arrivals, it is not necessary to check in before going to your cottage. Please check in at the park headquarters and pay your balance by noon the day after you arrive. Your cottage will be unlocked for your arrival. A key will be on the kitchen table. Please lock the cottage while you are out enjoying the park. At the end of your stay, please leave the key on the kitchen table and lock the door behind you.

Accommodations

Each two bedroom cottage sleeps up to eight people. Renters supply their own full size sheets, pillows, blankets and towels. Cottages are complete with full bath, kitchen, dining area, and living room. Cooking utensils and tableware for eight are included. Kitchens have microwaves and coffee makers.

Directions to Chatcolet Cottage

Travel 6 miles east on Hwy 5 from Plummer, ID. At the bottom of the steep hill, turn left on Chatcolet road. Travel 2 miles on Chatcolet Road, following signs to Chat campground. At the `Y` bear to the left and cross the cattle guard. Then take a right on Chatcolet Upper Road. At the next intersection, take a left (following Chatcolet Upper Road) Travel one-tenth of a mile. Chatcolet Cottage is on the right. The parking area is between the garage and cottage.

Directions to Lakeview Cottage

Travel 6 miles east on Hwy 5 from Plummer, ID. At the bottom of the steep hill, watch for Chatcolet road. Stay on Highway 5. Turn on Hawley's Landing Road, 100 yards east of Chatcolet Road. Stay to the right until it dead-ends at the Lakeview Cottage.

Directions to Rocky Point Cottage

Travel 7 miles east on Hwy 5 from Plummer, ID. Turn left on Rocky Point Loop Road, 1 mile east of Chatcolet Road. The cottage is the 5th on the right.
