

“Liability Waiver”

By booking a Idaho City Yurt:

you and your party agree to all terms and conditions detailed in this liability waiver.

- All parties understand that the use of and traveling to/from these yurts can be dangerous.
You and members of your party have carefully considered the risks which include, but are not limited to: being caught and disoriented in snowstorms; becoming lost and not finding the yurt; falling and colliding with trees, rocks, or other objects while skiing, snowshoeing, mountain biking, hiking, or horseback riding; becoming exhausted while traveling; being caught in an avalanche; developing frostbite or hypothermia; being hit by lightning; finding the yurt damaged; being injured using the yurt equipment.
- To minimize the risks, you and members of your party are in good health and have no physical limitations, which would preclude safe, use of the yurts. You and members of your party have read the yurt **manual** and **guides** that provide valuable information on how to get to the yurt, recommended equipment and the need to be prepared ,if necessary to spend the night outside.
- I knowingly and voluntarily assume all risks of injury that I may sustain while using and traveling to and from the yurt and waive, release and discharge the State of Idaho, the Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation, and the Boise National Forest from and against all liability to myself for any and all loss or damage, and/or claim, suit or demand on account of injury to my person or property, including death, whether due to normal or naturally occurring conditions, or otherwise. I certify that I have carefully read the above provisions, and know and understand the contents, and that by booking this facility, I agree to this Statement of Risk and Liability Waiver of my own free will.
