Poison Creek

From Donnelly, head West on Roseberry Rd. Continue with a slight left onto NF 427. Turn left onto W. Mountain Rd heading South on the west side of Cascade Lake. Continue through the roundabout and turn left for Poison Creek access.

Boulder Creek Access

From Donnelly head south on Hwy 55. After 1.5 miles turn right onto Old State Road. Continue to take a right onto Loomis Ln, left onto Spring Valley Rd, right onto Lake Trail Dr, left onto Cascade Dr, right onto Wildwood Dr, left onto Hereford Rd and finally a right at Boulder Creek access area.

Crown Point Access / Sugarloaf

From Cascade center, head north on Hwy 55/Main St. Before the Hwy Bridge take a left onto Lake Way for about .5 miles. Arrive at the Crown Point parking lot shortly after Dam Rd. For Sugarloaf stay on Hwy 55 for about 6.7 miles and turn left onto Stonebraker Ln. Limited parking provided in signed lot on southern side of Stonebraker Ln entrance.

Van Wyck / Blue Heron Access

From Cascade Center head North on Main St. Turn left onto Lake Cascade Pkwy. Continue for .5 miles to Van Wyck boat ramp and campground. Continue left at Lakeshore Dr., heading south for about 2 miles to arrive at Blue Heron
