PRESENTATION

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Eagle Island State Park's sanitary sewer needs are currently being served by multiple drain fields within the park. The construction of a new 50-unit campground has necessitated major infrastructure upgrades to connect the park to a public sewer system.

Eagle Sewer District has partnered with IDPR to provide sewer service to Eagle Island State Park. IDPR has designed the new sewer system to meet Eagle Sewer District standards, and the sewer system is currently being constructed under the Eagle Island RV Campground project. Once construction is complete the sewer system will be turned over to Eagle Sewer District to provide sewer service to the park. Maintenance of the system will be Eagle Sewer District's responsibility. The ROW is necessary so that Eagle Sewer District has access to service and maintain the sewer system. The sewer system will only serve Eagle Island State Park. If IDPR ever decides to cancel sewer service from Eagle Sewer District the ROW can be revoked.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends the Board authorize the IDPR Director to sign the Right-of-Way Agreement with Eagle Sewer District to provide sewer service to Eagle Island State Park.
