

Farragut Scott Field Area Forest Management

A 48-acre forest management project designed to address overcrowding and facilitate a new day use opportunity at Farragut is scheduled to be implemented and completed late fall/ winter of 2024/2025. This project will remove overstocked lodgepole, and thin Grand fir and Douglas fir to promote the vigor and resilience of the remaining trees and reduce the fuel loading in the project areas to the east and south of the Scott group camp and east of Flyers field (refer to map). Other objectives include removing trees from the historic base administration area east of flyers field to create a new day use and interpretive opportunity and associated parking and trailhead for visitors to enjoy.
