The Idaho State Parks Passport is an annual sticker for Idahoans that is available for purchase at the time you register your motorhome or passenger vehicle online, by mail-in renewal or at any county DMV office. The passport offers UNLIMITED day-use access to every Idaho State Park. It covers boat launch fees within Idaho State Parks. Non-residents can purchase an Annual passport and receive the same benefit.

#### **PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS DAY VISITORS**


To Beach

- Park Opens at 7AM and Closes at 10PM
- There are trailheads and parking on both the North and South sides of the park
- Trail Maps are available in the Visitor Center for \$1
- Pets must be on a 6' leash and accompanied at all times.
- Please pick up after your pet.
- No Pets are allowed at Beaver Bay Beach
- Do not approach harass or feed wildlife you may see
- Horse, Llama or any stock animal use is restricted to the park North of Hwy 54
- No Motorized toys allowed
