The Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation (IDPR) will accept applications for funding requests from the Land and Water Conservation Fund program starting May 1, 2026, until **August 14, 2026**. All applications must be submitted electronically via the IDPR website. The program funding opportunity link is accessed through the IDPR Grant webpage where applicants can start an application.

Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) is granted to local governments for outdoor recreation enhancements such as playgrounds, ball fields, swimming pools, tennis courts, etc.
