CREATE A BASKET DESIGN

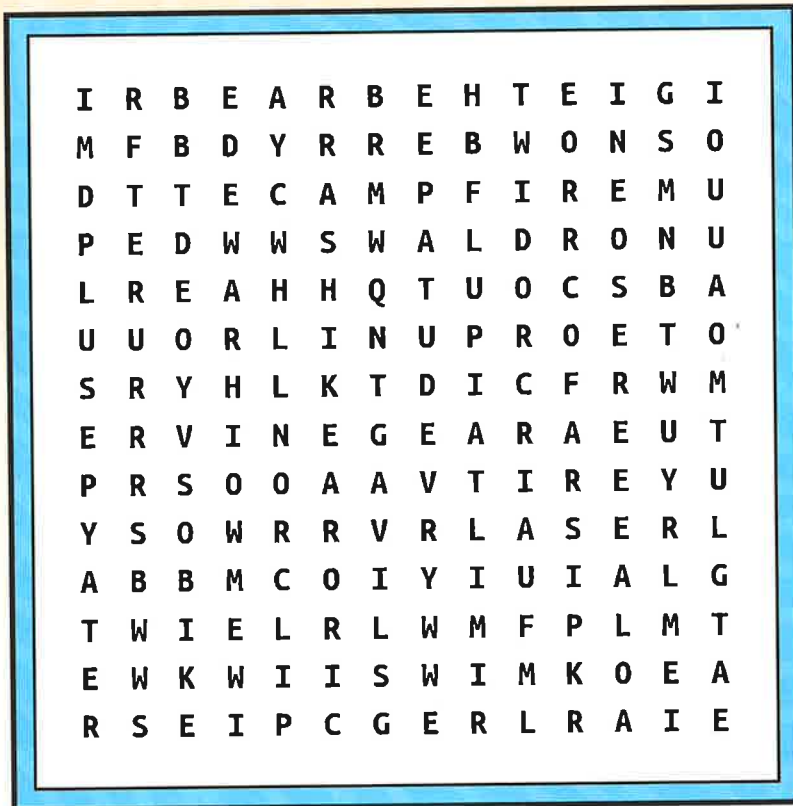
The Cataldo Mission is Idaho's Oldest Standing Building. It was constructed in 1850 by members of the Coeur d'Alene Tribe and Catholic missionaries. The ceiling inside is blue, but it is not paint. It is stained with Huckleberries!

Many children and adults worked to gather the berries and paint the ceiling. Huckleberries are similar in size and taste to a blueberry. Can you imagine how many berries were picked and how many were eaten in the process? Inside the visitor center museum, you can see huckleberry gathering baskets on display.
