You're invited to star gaze at the Bruneau Dunes Observatory! View planets, nebulae, or a galaxy through our 27.5" & 25" telescopes. Our newest observatory is also a planetarium!

Observatory tours, planetarium programs and solar viewing (through a solar telescope) are available in the evening before the sun goes down.

There will be two 25-minute astronomy presentations inside the Steele-Reese Education Center followed by a viewing of the heavens through the Observatory's collection of telescopes.

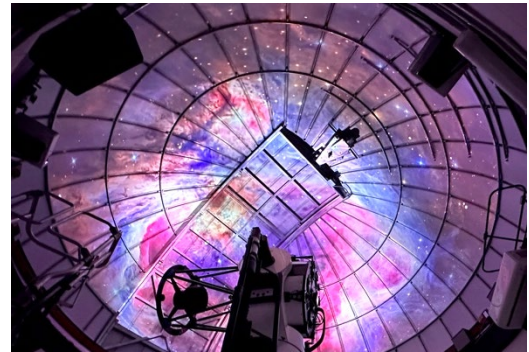

## **Public Program Fees**

- **Individual** .....\$5
- **Family**.....\$20  
(Parents with their minor children)
- **Children (5 and under)** .....Free
- **Student** (on school field trip).....\$3

Private Observatory Tours and School field trips are available on Thursday nights during season. Costs for Private tours are \$300 for the first 15 people (minimum) and \$10/person thereafter. A non-refundable \$25 application fee applies.

Costs for Private School groups are \$150 for the first 15 students (minimum) and \$10/person thereafter. A non-refundable \$25 application fee applies.
