

IDAHO STATE PARKS VETERAN PASS PROGRAM

The Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation offers eligible Idaho Veterans a lifetime pass Veterans Parks Card with the following benefits:

<u>Day Use</u>: Waives the Motor Vehicle Entrance Fee for one personal vehicle.

<u>Camping:</u> Waives the Usage Fees for one campsite per eligible veteran. This does not include cabins, yurts, or lodges. Reservation Fees still apply. 14-night limit in a 30 day period at any park.

Passes are Non-Transferrable.

ELIGIBILITY

Veterans who are:

- A Resident of Idaho
- Service-connected disability
- VA rating of 100% Permanent & Total
 * must meet all three requirements

LOST OR STOLEN PASSES
