PRESENTATION

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Department has seventeen (10) citizen advisory committee positions to appoint.

Open Positions include: two Recreational Vehicle Fund positions, two Waterways Improvement Fund positions, three Off-Road Motor Vehicle Fund positions, and three Recreational Trails Program Fund positions.

Following this agenda item is a summary of the candidates and staff recommendations as well as the application forms from each applicant with pertinent registration information for the equipment the potential applicant owns.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends that the Board nominate and appoint committee members to the appropriate committees from the applicant list provided.

The Department has ten (10) citizen advisory committee positions expiring this year.

Positions to be appointed include:

- Two (2) Recreational Vehicle Fund
- Two (2) Waterways Improvement Fund
- Three (3) Off-Road Motor Vehicle Fund
- Three (3) Recreational Trails Program

Recreational Vehicle Fund Advisory Committee

IDPR needs to fill the Recreational Vehicle Fund positions for Districts IV and VI. To date, IDPR staff has received two (2) applications. The candidates meet the minimum criteria and are eligible for appointment.

District IV

John Howard is from Twin Falls, Idaho and is a current member of the National Wild Turkey Federation, Ducks Unlimited, Mule Deer Foundation, Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation and Safari Club International. He is born and raised in Idaho and is extensively involved in conservation while also being an avid hunter and fisherman for over 40 years. Of the many boards and committees John has been a part of, he has served as President, VP, and Grant applications/reviews/awards person. Equipment: 2015 Evergreen Tesla 5th Wheel Camper – on file and current (2022).

District VI

Kristine Staten is from Idaho Falls and is a frequent camper in Bonneville, Jefferson, Butte, Custer, and Fremont counties. She also has a background working with public infrastructure and economic development grants. Equipment: 2014 Heartland Cyclone 3100 – on file and current (2022).

Recommendation:

IDPR staff recommends appointing **John Howard** to District IV and appointing **Kristine Staten** to District VI on the Recreational Fund Advisory Committee.

Waterways Improvement Fund Advisory Committee

IDPR needs to fill the Waterways Improvement Fund positions for Districts V and VI. To date, IDPR staff has received one (1) application. The candidate meets the minimum criteria and is eligible for appointment.

District V

We currently do not have any applications for this district. The position will remain vacant until a suitable candidate can be found.

District VI

Recommendation:

IDPR staff recommends appointing **Kent Bateman** to District VI on the Waterways Improvement Fund Committee.

Off-road Motor Vehicle Committee

IDPR needs to fill the Off-Road Motor Vehicle positions for Districts III & IV (Motorbike/ATV), Districts III & IV (Snowmobiling), and Districts V & VI (Motorbike/ATV). To date, IDPR staff has received seven (7) applications. Most candidates meet the minimum criteria and are eligible for appointment.

District III

ATV/Motorbike

Benjamin Esplin is from Donnelly, Idaho. He is a Licensed guide through the Idaho Outfitters and Guides Licensing Board and has owned and operated UTV's, snowmobiles and dirt bikes for over 20 years. He also owns and operates Mountain Meadow Adventure Rentals, located in Donnelly, McCall, Murphy, and Wallace. As Benjamin rides frequently all over the state, he has gained knowledge of trail conditions and useability. **Equipment:** 2021XP 1000RZR– on file and current (2022).

Ryan McMillan is from Nampa, Idaho, and rides trails all over the State of Idaho. District III

Rick Dolphus is from Boise, Idaho and has been an avid outdoor and recreational enthusiast for over 45 years. He belongs to multiple off-road clubs and organizations, working to promote responsible use through this grant program and recognizing areas of need. **Equipment:** 2010 Polaris 800 Dragon 155 & 2013 Polaris RZR 800 – on file and current (2022).

District V

ATV/Motorbike

David Green is from Pocatello, Idaho. He is a lifelong resident of Idaho and has 43 years of trail riding and clearing experience. David has knowledge of and has spent time in many areas in Idaho while enjoying many hobbies, shared use is very important to him. He is a member of the Blue-Ribbon Coalition and the Wood River Trails Coalition. **Equipment:** 2019 KTM 300 – on file and current (2022).

District VI

William Yonke is from Ammon, Idaho and is a longtime and avid outdoors person. Scott has lived in the Mountain West for over 20 years and understands the balance needed to meet the needs of all users. **Equipment:** 2021 Beta 300 race addition – on file and current (2022).

Jeffrey Nofsinger is from Salmon, Idaho, he has previously held membership with the Boise Ridge Riders, building and maintaining trails in the Idaho City area for over 20 years. Jeffrey has ridden snowmobiles and ORV's in Idaho and has worked with state and federal agencies on projects in multiple locations. This position is for ATV/Motorbike, not snowmobile. No applicable equipment designated to meet the requirements for the open position.

Recommendation:

IDPR staff recommends appointing **Ben Esplin** to District III/IV for ATV/Motorbike position; appointing **Rick Dolphus** to District III/IV Snowmobile position; and appointing **Scott Sheer** to District V/VI ATV/Motorbike position on the Off-Road Motor Vehicle Fund Advisory Committee.

Recreational Trail Program Advisory Committee

IDPR needs to fill three (3) Recreational Trails Program positions for 4-Wheel Drive, Biking and Equestrian. To date, IDPR staff has received three (3) applications.

District 1

Paul Loutzenhiser is from Athol, Idaho and belongs to the North Idaho Trailblazers. He has spent several years working with the US Forest Service, BLM, and the CDA trails working group on our local trails. Paul has owned and managed his own company for over 14 years in Coeur d'Alene and would like to represent the 4-wheel Drive faction. Paul owns a Jeep.

District V

Stephen Hurley is from Pocatello, Idaho, as a current member and president of the Portneuf River County Horsemen, and President of the Over the Hill Gang horseback group, he would like to meet our Equestrian need on the RTP committee. Stephen has a good working knowledge and experience in evaluating published research, excellent knowledge of statics and facilitated grant applications for the Pocatello Free Clinic. He also belongs to the Caribou Forrest Initiative, a member of the Idaho Trails Association, and member of the City of Pocatello Trails Working Group.

Recreational Trail Program Advisory Committee (continued)

Stacey Sorensen is from Soda Springs, Idaho and as an avid bike rider would qualify for our bicycling representation. She was a volunteer working on the rivers, trails, horse drop off areas and backcountry restoration projects. Stacey has also worked with the Forest Service clearing and maintaining trails, developing watering areas for wildlife, and took several land resources classes in college. As a member of Save our Rivers and Trails Backcountry Restoration group, wilderness, and backcountry education/rescue, she would bring insight to the committee.

IDPR staff recommends appointing **Paul Loutzenhiser** to represent 4-Wheel Drive; appointing **Stephen Hurley** to represent equestrian; and appointing **Stacey Sorensen** to represent biking on the Recreational Trail Program Advisory Committee. With the new appointments, this committee meets the Board Policy that not more than two individuals serve in any one Board district.
